Sailing Instructions

Brixham Heritage Rally, Saturday 25th September 2021, Torbay

REGISTRATION: online by 1700 Friday 24th September to penny@brixhamheritageregatta.uk

SKIPPERS' BRIEFING: 12:00 hours Saturday 25th September on VHF Channel 8

ENTRY: All starters must have lodged an entry form by 1700 hours Friday 18th September, including a signature, contact details and a declaration of adequate third party insurance. No Entry Fee.

IDENTIFICATION

All entrants should indicate sail number or other identifier to rally officer together with number of persons on board prior to the start by VHF radio. Heritage pennants, if available from previous years, should be prominently displayed either on the backstay or from the gaff peak.

COURSE, CLASSES & START, FINISH

The objective is to carry out a 'sail in company' starting at Battery Point and navigating the southern part of Torbay in a clockwise direction unless otherwise advised by VHF. The suggested course is all marks to starboard commencing with BYC "B", Torquay "X", BYC "E" and return via Brixham Fairway "Green". Vessels may continue sailing as many laps or directions as they please after the first lap, however on returning to Brixham skippers should inform the Rally organisers by VHF that they have ceased Rally sailing for the day. The intention is to sail during the afternoon until approximately 16.00.

We expect the Brixham trawlers "Pilgrim BM 45" and "Vigilance BM76" to lead the fleet out as below:

SAIL PAST

All trawlers, working vessels and yachts (Classes 1, 2a,2b,3,4,5 & 6) should leave harbour in sufficient time to sail between harbour entrance and Battery Point, so that we provide an interesting spectacle for viewers ashore. Take care to leave sufficient room and to provide a reasonable fairway for other vessels entering and leaving Brixham Harbour. The recommendation is to pass through the outer harbour fairway from approximately 12:30 onwards. The objective should be to pass near Battery Point prior to the nominated start time in order to positively identify your vessel to the organisers.

RALLY RULES

- ❑ Sailing will be organised in accordance with the intent of current Rules of Sailing and in particular with the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea.
- ❑ Before and during the Regatta, vessels in Classes 2 to 6 shall give way to all Class 1 vessels at all times, maintaining a minimum distance of 50 metres.

COMMITTEE VESSEL

This is intended to be large RIB "Olympic" (possibly with a photographer on board). In addition another BYC RIB may be in attendance with call sign "Safety 1"

COMMUNICATION

Rally communication will be VHF Channel 8, unless otherwise advised. A listening watch shall be kept by all vessels on this channel before and during the event for Rally announcements from "Heritage Rally Control". Communication with Brixham Harbour for berthing and other facilities should be on channel 14. For fuel please contact Brixham Marina.
