

Heritage Rally Sept 19th 2020 – Covid 19 compliance

The following notes and instructions are mandatory in order to comply with the Covid 19 risk assessment arrangements that are put in place to achieve ALARP (as low as practicable) risks from the current pandemic for the specific activities of this event.

All participants and organisers are required to comply with the current UK England regulations and guidelines for Covid 19 risk reduction as current at the time of the event.

1. This a sailing only event taking place entirely outdoors
2. All participants including crew and supporters are to be registered with their contact details for use in any track and trace events.
3. Boats are required to be at least 5metres apart when sailing
4. Skippers are entirely responsible for the risks to their crew
5. Crew should be either a maximum of 6 persons within a known “bubble” or if larger numbers are on board should operate with adequate social distancing as specified in that particular vessel’s risk assessment.
6. Rafting to be discouraged on visitors moorings or pontoons
7. Skippers to ensure that crew visiting ashore comply with all social distancing and hygiene provisions of premises entered including the wearing of face coverings where required
8. Entrance to Brixham Yacht Club to be by invitation only following booking of tables as available.
